- If you haven't already, it is helpful for you to share the following with the teacher:
 - **General information** about your child, which may include strengths, weaknesses, likes/dislikes, special needs, unique home situations, etc.
 - **Previous school experiences**, whether positive or negative.
 - **Concerns** that you may have so you and your child's teacher may work together to solve the problem in a positive manner.
- Questions to consider asking the teacher include:
 - What are my child's **strengths and weaknesses**?
 - Does my child give his/her best **effort**?
 - How is my child doing **socially and emotionally**?
 - How can I help my child at home?

Parent/teacher conferences are a great time to briefly meet and foster a positive school and home communication/connection. It also shows your child that you value and want to be actively involved in his/her education. We look forward to meeting with you!
