#### JH/HS

- Teachers will post instructions/assignments on Google Classroom by 8:15 a.m.
- Teachers will be available via email and Google Meets for student assistance between the hours of 8:15 a.m. 11:30 a.m. & 12:00 p.m. 1:20 p.m.
  - To set up a Google Meets session, please email the teacher. The teacher will respond to set up a Google Meets for further assistance.
  - If circumstances arise that a teacher can't meet via Google Meets, the teacher needs to contact the appropriate building principal.

## **TECHNOLOGY**

- It is understood that most households have access to the internet either on a computer or cell phone device.
- If a student in  $3^{rd} 12^{th}$  grades needs a Chromebook for use at home, contact the appropriate office, and one will be provided.
- Students may complete the work electronically and email to the appropriate teacher or on paper to turn into the teacher by the due date.
- The school district will continue to work with families in the event that internet access is not available. For students with limited access to the internet, packets will be made available on the first day back to school.

## **GOOGLE MEETS EXPECTATIONS**

- Google Meets will be used for face to face instruction if requested by a student or teacher.
- Students are to have their cameras on and face visible during the entire Google Meets session.
- Students are expected to be dressed properly for Google Meets sessions.
- Students are not to have any offensive or school inappropriate materials visible during Google Meets sessions.
- Students must enter the Google Meet with their microphone muted and request to unmute by raising their hand via Meets icon.

#### SPECIAL EDUCATION AND MTSS SERVICES

- Special Education teachers, school counselors, MTSS teachers, and the school nurse will be available to parents and students on e-learning days.
  - These professionals may be accessed through their school email addresses between the hours of 8:15 a.m. 1:20 p.m.
- To ensure that services of special education students are met, students with special needs will have assignments modified or provided based on their IEP goals from their special education teacher or related service provider.

#### **HOMEWORK**

- Students will access their learning through the use of Teacherease, Google Classroom, Google Meets, or school provided packets.
- All work will be due the day after students are back in session in order for teachers to verify participation and monitor progress.

## EXTRA-CURRICULAR AND SCHOOL EVENTS

- Extra-curricular events and school functions may be canceled in the event of e-learning days. This includes but is not limited to practice, games, clubs, extra-curricular events, trips, or special events on these days.
- Information pertaining to this will be shared via Teacherease, the school website, and the school Facebook page.
